

# SALEM MONTHLY MEETING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND

## GUIDELINES

It is the intention of the Salem Education Scholarship Committee of the Salem Monthly Meeting to provide grants for "the education of members of Salem Monthly Meeting" as instructed by the members of this committee.

The term "education" is to be determined by the committee and to include those attending high school and college. It is limited to private day and boarding high schools and all colleges including community colleges.

The committee has a limited amount of funds to disperse and will make every effort to honor all requests. The funds are available from the interest of a bequest of money, which is invested. The number of students applying, the interest rate, and the type of school where the student attends, determines the amount of each disbursement.

Those attending a private boarding high school, and a boarding college get the largest disbursement, second by those attending a private day high school. It is not limited to those attending a Quaker School.

The following information from those seeking grants is necessary to the committee:

1. Immediate family must be **ACTIVE MEMBERS** in good standing of **SALEM MONTHLY MEETING**.
2. Your name, address, telephone number, and date of birth.
3. Your parents or legal guardian name, address, and telephone number.
4. Name, address, of school you are attending
5. Type of school; college, high school, boarding or day.
6. Applicant's year in school for which the grant is to be applied.
7. All applications must be received no later than **February 15**.
8. All monies will be dispersed twice a year in the months of August and February
